Textile Artist Badge Workshop

Date: Saturday, April 22, 2017

This workshop is designed for Seniors (ages 15-16), but Cadettes (ages 12-14) may also enjoy exploring the fiber arts.

At the Textile Artist Badge Workshop you will interview a fiber artist who works with natural fibers and learn how they are modernizing traditional techniques. Explore the different types of fleece and how it becomes thread and then fabrics for clothing or for art. Collect samples and develop a chart about their origin, texture, dye, and use.

Drawing Badge Workshop

This workshop is designed for Juniors (ages 10-12), but Cadettes (ages 12-14) may also enjoy learning the techniques.

The Drawing Badge Workshop will provide an opportunity to produce color and black and white drawings, using colored pencils and graphite pencils. Different types of paper will be available. The instructors will provide guidance on shading and adding perspective to the drawings and participants will learn to apply the techniques.

This workshop is designed for Cadettes (ages 12-14) but Juniors (ages 10-12) and Seniors (ages 15-16), but may also enjoy working with the clay.

At the Cadette Outdoor Apprentice workshop you will meet with artists who paints, photographs, or sculpts the outdoor world around us. Use modeling clay to create something from nature: a sheep, llama, tree, flower, or.... The clay piece will be yours to keep or give as a gift.
